









## SPARKLING WINE & CHAMPAGNE

#### CAVA CALAMINO NV, SPAIN £25.15

Fresh and harmonious, displaying plenty of apple and toast flavours, yet intensely dry and mouth-watering

### PROSECCO CORTE ALTA NV, DOC, ITALY £28.85

Delicate and aromatic with a light body and fine bubbles, this wine carries lots of fresh peach, pear, apricot and apple with a revitalising finish

#### J DE TELMONT GRANDE RÉSERVE NV £45.65

One of the few remaining, family owned Champagne houses, De Telmont produces this excellent non-vintage in a medium bodied, soft and fruity, classically yeasty style

### OEIL DE PERDRIX ROSÉ NV £66.65

Meaning 'eye of the partridge', this pale salmon pink rosé Champagne exhibits enticing complexity. Delicate in style, but with a perfect weight of fruit. A fantastic apéritif

#### LAURENT-PERRIER BRUT NV £82.40

Subtle citrus, toast and spice predominate this perfectly balanced Champagne, with a strong structure giving the wine good food compatibility



### **CELLAR SELECTION WINES**

### FINCA NOVA AIRÉN, SPAIN £17.85

Pale lemon in colour with clean, fresh and fruity aromas. Soft citrus flavours predominate on the palate, with a crisp finish.

#### FINCA NOVA TEMPRANILLO, SPAIN £17.85

Classic notes of dark cherry and blackcurrant are lifted by a hint of dried flowers and spice. Superbly balanced, the fruits of the forest flavours are perfectly complemented by soft tannins.



### WHITE WINES

### MARQUES DE CALADO MACABEO, VINO DE LA TIERRA CASTILLA, SPAIN £24.10

Fresh, floral aromas reminiscent of aromatic herbs such as anise and fennel, the smooth and velvety palate is fruit driven with citrus flavours

#### TAVINO TREBBIANO, ITALY £24.10

Pale in colour with aromas of citrus and melon which follow onto the palate with a lovely splash of zest and green apple

### MICHEL SERVIN BLANC, VIN DE FRANCE £24.65

Light and straightforward, with an up-front nose of citrus fruit, tinged with a subtle leafy character. Crisp and dry on the palate, with plenty of refreshing acidic bite

#### FIVE FOOT TRACK CHARDONNAY, AUSTRAILIA £26.20

Pale straw yellow with youthful green hues. A nose of citrus fruits and ripe apples, with underlying notes of vanilla. Crisp lemon and lime on the palate, served up with a rounded and buttery feel

### BANTRY BAY CHENIN BLANC, WESTERN CAPE, SOUTH AFRICA £26.75

An aromatic wine with hints of tropical and citrus fruit on the nose and palate

### LA TIERRA ROSCOSA SAUVIGNON BLANC, CHILE £27.80

Crisp and refreshing, this wine offers an abundance of passion fruit, grapefruit and lemon fruit flavours, delivered in a softer, more tropical fruit texture



## WHITE WINES (continued)

### MALANDRINO PINOT GRIGIO, VENETO, ITALY £29.35

The pale hue of the wine gives way to hints of perfume, pears, stone fruit and lime, as well as the occasional floral note. Fresh and vibrant acidity results in a light, easy drinking wine

#### CAMINO REAL BLANCO RIOJA, SPAIN £29.90

An interesting and complex wine. Ripe fruit flavours with notes of date and banana results in a mouth filling finish and pleasant aftertaste

#### PICPOUL PLO D'ISABELLE, SOUTH OF FRANCE £32.00

Youthfully pale lemon yellow, with a nose of lemon and lime fruit, and an intriguing blend of white blossom and green herb notes. Vibrant green apple fruit with a refreshingly dry and acidic finish

### FATHOMS SAUVIGNON BLANC, MARLBOROUGH, NEW ZEALAND £34.60

Typical of Marlborough Sauvignon, the bouquet springs from the glass, offering plumes of citrus, green grass and elderflower. The palate is a burst of crisp grapefruit and gooseberry flavours

### MONTAGNY GRAND VIN DE BOURGOGNE BUXY, BURGANDY £37.25

This Montagny offers ripe lemon aromas, accompanied by subtle hints of white blossom. More refreshing citrus flavours on the palate, and an elegant, steely dry finish



### **ROSE WINES**

### LE BOIS DES VIOLETTES ROSÉ, PAYS D'OC £25.70

A fresh salmon-pink rosé giving delicious strawberry, cherry fruits on the palate. A fantastic balance between the acidity and fruit characters results in an off-dry rosé

### TORRE ALTA PINOT GRIGIO ROSÉ, VENETO £27.25

This wine shows why rose is so popular. Beautiful soft strawberry flavours with floral notes



### **RED WINES**

### MARQUES DE CALADO TEMPRANILLO, VINO DE LA TIERRA CASTILLA, SPAIN £24.10

Classic Tempranillo notes of dark cherry and blackcurrant are lifted by a hint of dried flowers and spice. Superbly balanced, the fruits of the forest flavours are perfectly complemented by soft tannins

### TAVINO SANGIOVESE, ITALY £24.10

Aromas of cherries, raspberry and plums follow onto the palate with juicy tannins giving a lovely smooth texture

### FIVE FOOT TRACK SHIRAZ, AUSTRALIA £25.70

A medium weight red, with a pleasing balance between ripe fruit and savoury, earthy notes on the nose. The palate is succulent and mouth-filling, with lashings of red berry and brambles

#### LA TIERRA ROCOSA MERLOT, CHILE £26.20

Ample red berry fruit combining fresh acidity with ripeness and warmth. Offers good concentration and depth, a soft and plummy texture, and hints of vanilla and spice

### FLOR DEL FUEGO CABERNET SAUVIGNON, CHILE £26.75

Fruity flavours of plum and blackcurrant, with a cassis-like concentration, lifted by subtle green-pepper-like savoury tinges. Easy-going tannins provide a ripe and friendly mouthfeel

### AIRES ANDINOS MALBEC, MENDOZA, ARGENTINA £29.35

Deep ruby coloured with smoky black fruits of cassis, blackberry and spice. The concentration of the wine performs well above its price point with soft tannins and a long finish



### **RED WINES (continued)**

### BARON DE BAUSSAC CARIGNAN, SOUTH OF FRANCE £29.90

Deep and inky red in colour, the wine is crammed with black cherry fruit, lifted by subtle vanilla aromas from a touch of oak ageing. Bold, meaty tannins provide satisfying texture and length

# OLTRE PASSO PRIMITIVO, IGT SALENTO, ITALY £30.40 Deep, dense ruby in colour, with a nose of warm prunes, dates and figs, with hints of sweet spice. Full and voluptuous, the mouth-feel is soft and plush, with toasty notes that linger on the finish

#### TORRE ALDEA TINTO, RIOJA, SPAIN £32.00

A deep bright red cherry colour with persistent aromas of ripe fruit and berries. Long and lingering with great harmony and a wonderful aftertaste

## ST DESIR PINOT NOIR, PAYS D'OC, FRANCE £34.10 Showing violets and sweet red berries on the nose the palate is rich, velvety and full, with well-integrated oak

### ESPRIT DE LUSSAC ST EMILION, BORDEAUX £37.25

Deep ruby coloured with smoky black fruits of cassis, blackberry and spice. The concentration of the wine performs well above its price point with soft tannins and a long finish
